60-DAY NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE AN APPLICATION

Fort Covington Solar, LLC (Fort Covington Solar) is proposing to construct the Fort Covington Solar Project, a major solar electric generating facility, under Section 94-c of the Executive Law (Section 94-c). This notice announces that on or about June 28, 2024, Fort Covington Solar intends to file an Application with the Office of Renewable Energy Siting ("ORES" or the "Office"), pursuant to Section 94-c seeking a Siting Permit from the Office authorizing the construction, operation and ultimately, the decommissioning of the Fort Covington Solar Project. The 94-c process has been implemented by rules enacted by the Office and establishes a review process with uniform standards and conditions for all renewable energy projects. The uniform standards and conditions are available at 19 NYCRR 900-6 and www.ores.ny.gov/regulations.

The Fort Covington Solar Project is proposed to be an approximately 250-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located in the Town of Fort Covington, Franklin County, New York (the "Facility"). The Facility will include solar arrays and other project infrastructure such as access roads, inverters, collection, substation, and electrical interconnection to the National Grid 345 kV circuit.

The Facility is a zero-emission solar energy facility that will assist the State in meeting the goals of the Climate Leadership and Protection Act and State Energy Plan, which includes obtaining 70% of energy generation from renewable sources by 2030 and significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Other positive impacts of the Facility include diversification of energy supplies, new employment opportunities (both temporary construction and full-time employment), increased revenues to the Town of Fort Covington, Franklin County, and Salmon River School District, payments to participating landowners, support of the local hospitality industry, and purchase of local supplies and goods. In addition, Fort Covington Solar has attempted to minimize impacts associated with the Facility, for example, by limiting impacts to wetlands, streams, agricultural resources, forests and other resources to the maximum extent practicable. Fort Covington Solar will submit an Application that includes extensive studies evaluating the potential impacts associated with the Facility and identified methods which have been agreed to be implemented to avoid, minimize and mitigate potential impacts. This notice is being provided in accordance with 19 NYCRR 900-1.3(d) and is being published at least sixty (60) days prior to the filing of the Application.

WIPE OUT CERVICAL CANCER! We have the power to wipe out cervical cancer. Yet, a recent U.S. study shows that more cervical cancers are being diagnosed at a later stage, when the cancer may have already spread, and less at an early stage, when treatment works best. The biggest increase was seen among Black women. New York

State data also show that Black women are more likely than white women to be diagnosed with cervical cancer and also to die from the disease. We have the tools to find cervical cancer early or completely prevent it. The first tool is regular cervical cancer screening. Cervical cancer screening tests can find the cells that lead to cancer before it starts. These cells can then be removed. This prevents cancer! Screening also helps to find cervical cancer early when it may be easier to treat. The second tool is the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine. HPV causes nearly all cases of cervical cancer and several other cancers. The HPV vaccine prevents about 90% of HPV-related cancers. The HPV vaccine is recommended for children starting at age 9 and young adults through age 26. If you have a cervix, start screening at age 21 and get screened every three years until age 65. Talk to your doctor
