first tool is regular cervical cancer screening. Cervical cancer screening tests can find the cells that lead to cancer before it starts. These cells can then be removed. This prevents cancer! Screening also helps to find cervical cancer early when it may be easier to treat. The second tool is the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine. HPV causes nearly all cases of cervical cancer and several other cancers. The HPV vaccine prevents about 90% of HPV-related cancers. The HPV vaccine is recommended for children starting at age 9 and young adults through age 26. If you have a cervix, start screening at age 21 and get screened every three years until age 65. Talk to your doctor after age 65 to see if you should still be screened. While the HPV vaccine is very effective in preventing cervical cancer, you should still be screened regularly. If you don't have insurance, the Cancer Services Program (CSP) of Northeastern NY provides free cervical cancer screening to those aged 40 and older who qualify. Most health insurers cover screening at no cost for those with insurance. Make a resolution to call your health care provider or call us at 518-324-7671 to see if you qualify for a free cervical cancer screening.

Licensure Compacts Would Help Address Rural Health Care Shortage

Joining the Nursing Licensure Compact and the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact would increase the number of health care professionals who could work in New York.

Access to health care in our upstate communities has never been more challenged than it is today. One reason for that is the fact that reimbursement rates that have not kept pace with the rising costs of delivering care; another reason is the **sustained shortage of health care workers**. While we are relieved that the state Legislature has taken serious steps toward closing the Medicaid reimbursement gap in future years, that will only solve one piece of the complex challenges rural health care is facing. That's why we are calling on our elected officials to also address the crippling staffing shortages impacting our facilities and others across New York.

A great step forward would be to pass a set of bills (A.6421 and A.4860) that would permit our state to join both the Nursing Licensure Compact and the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact. **This would increase the labor pool of immediately available health care professionals**—temporary or traveling staff and those relocating to our community—recognized by New York state and allow hospitals and nursing homes to more quickly fill vacancies.

Traveling staff continue to play an integral role in the delivery of high-quality and equitable care in our communities. In fact, they're fixtures in many rural facilities because recruitment and retention of permanent health care professionals continues to be difficult. According to the Healthcare Association of New York, 98% of hospitals statewide continue to report nursing shortages, and more than three-quarters of those facilities say they could increase availability of existing services or reduce patient wait times if those vacancies were filled. The Iroquois Healthcare Association indicates that in July 2023, the vacancy rate for all health care facilities represented by their organization was **138% higher** than before the pandemic. For registered nurses, that rate was **164% higher**.

At Alice Hyde Medical Center in Malone and at Plattsburgh's Champlain Valley Physicians Hospital, we see how shortages at every level of care affect the movement of patients through the health care system. We see the toll it takes on them and our dedicated staff. **When understaffed nursing homes or post-acute facilities are unable to accept our patients, those patients must stay in the hospital when they would clearly benefit from the specialized care offered in, for example, a long-term care or rehabilitation facility.** This stretches our inpatient capacity, often resulting in longer wait times in our emergency departments, and leads to poor patient experience, increased costs to payers and providers, and staff burnout.

Because New York is not part of the Nursing Licensure Compact, the traveling staff members we recruit often face start time delays related to the state licensure process, leading them to take another assignment in one of the 41 states that recognize their licenses via participation in the compact. Eleven of the traveling nurses CVPH expected to begin work recently have either taken assignments in other states or have had their start date delayed while their New York license applications were pending.

By increasing our access to nurses and other care providers, joining the Nursing Licensure Compact and Interstate Medical Licensure Compact would have a positive impact on our patients and our people. It would be an important step to ensure that those of us in the most rural parts of our state continue to have equitable access to health care services, while offering our dedicated but beleaguered teams welcome relief.
