

This notice announces that, on or about **February 23, 2026**, Brookside Solar LLC (Brookside Solar or Permit Holder) will commence construction of the Brookside solar project a 100-megawatt (MW) Solar Electric Generating Facility located in the Towns of Burke and Chateaugay, Franklin County, NY (the Facility).

Pursuant to Article VIII of the New York State Public Service Law (the Article VIII process), this notice is being provided in accordance with *Section 5, Subsection 5.2(a)* of the Facility's Siting Permit for a Major Renewable Energy Facility, which was issued by the Office of Renewable Energy Siting and Electric Transmission (ORES) on December 8, 2023. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

Brookside Solar will construct the Facility in the Towns of Burke and Chateaugay, Franklin County. When completed, the Facility will consist of the following major components: PV arrays and their rack/support systems; direct current (DC) collection lines and communications cables connecting the arrays to inverters; the inverters with their support platforms, control electronics, and step-up transformers; buried AC medium voltage collection lines; security fencing and gates around each PV array; gravel access roads; temporary laydown areas; medium voltage to transmission voltage collection substation with associated equipment, and fenced areas; point of interconnection (POI) switchyard with associated equipment and fenced areas; and two (2) overhead 115- kilovolt (kV) transmission lines to connect the interconnection switchyard to the existing New York State Electric and Gas (NYSEG) Line 911 Willis Road to Chateaugay transmission line POI.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Phase I of construction consisting of tree felling is scheduled to begin on or about February 23, 2026. Thereafter, construction will proceed according to the below phases and approximate schedule:

- Site Preparation and Civil Construction in or around June 2026

All construction activities shall be limited to 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 8 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Sunday and on national holidays.



seen among Black women. New York State data also show that Black women are more likely than white women to be diagnosed with cervical cancer and also to die from the disease. We have the tools to find cervical cancer early or completely prevent it. The first tool is regular cervical cancer screening. Cervical cancer screening tests can find the cells that lead to cancer before it starts. These cells can then be removed. This prevents cancer! Screening also helps to find cervical cancer early when it may be easier to treat. The second tool is the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine. HPV causes nearly all cases of cervical cancer and several other cancers. The HPV vaccine prevents about 90% of HPV-related cancers. The HPV vaccine is recommended for children starting at age 9 and young adults through age 26. If you have a cervix, start screening at age 21 and get screened every three years until age 65. Talk to your doctor after age 65 to see if you should still be screened. While the HPV vaccine


